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**REGULATION ON
QUESTIONNAIRE OF THE STUDENT SATISFACTION ASSESSMENT FROM PRACTICE
OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TRADITIONAL MEDICINE**

1. General provisions

The Rules of Procedure for Assessing Students' Satisfaction with Internships Organized by the Specialized Educational Programs of the University of Traditional Medicine (hereinafter referred to as the UTM) define the procedure for conducting surveys, processing and using the results among the UTM's interns.

- 1.2. process, is conducted on the basis of the RA Law on Education, the current monitoring and review procedure of the UTM's speciality education programs.
- 1.3. The purpose of the survey is to obtain information on the theoretical knowledge of the UTM's interns on practical experience, organization of the internship process, location, location, internship.

2. Conducting the survey

- 2.1. The survey is conducted among the University interns using the questionnaire attached to this regulation (Appendix 1).
- 2.2. The survey is conducted immediately after the end of each internship, within one to two weeks.
- 2.3. The survey is conducted by the University's Education part.
- 2.4. The survey is conducted according to the evaluation questionnaire attached to this regulation.
- 2.5. The survey is anonymous, conducted on paper, as well as online.

3. The maintenance and development of the survey

- 3.1. Survey results are processed and analyzed by the leading specialist of the Educational part and Quality Assurance.
- 3.3. The questionnaires have sections of opinions, suggestions, the results of which are developed and presented in the form of generalized suggestions for improvement.
- 3.4. The survey results are processed and analyzed within a month.
- 3.5. Deletions and corrections in the questionnaires do not count.
- 3.6. Evaluated questionnaires and analyzes are kept in the Educational part for 5 years.

4. Use of survey results

- 4.1. Based on the analysis of the survey results, the educational part discusses with the deans of the faculties, the heads of the departments, the internships of the faculties, develops a package of suggestions for the improvement of the internship.
- 4.2. Based on the package of suggestions, the Educational part develops an improvement action plan and submits it to the SC.
- 4.3. Information on the results of the survey is published on the official website of the UTM.

5. Final provisions

- 5.1. The UTM's survey regulations are approved, and amendments and additions are made by the UTM's Academic Council.
- 5.2. This Regulation shall enter into force upon approval by the Scientific Council.
