REGULATION

ON STUDENT SCIENTIFIC SOCIETY OF UNIVERSITY OF TRADITIONAL MEDICINE

I. General provisions

- 1.1 The UTM's Student Scientific Society (hereinafter referred to as SSU or the Society) is a university unit uniting students of the UTM, whose goal is to contribute to the scientific, creative and spiritual development of students.
- 1.2 The society operates on the basis of the UTM's Charter and this Regulation.
- 1.3 The Regulation of the society and the changes made to it are approved by the Scientific Council of the UTM, upon the presentation of the student department.
- 1.4 The society, according to the established procedure, can have a corner stamp, a logo, a letter of appointment.
- 1.5 The society regulates its relations with the governing bodies of the UTM by the UTM regulation, this regulation and relevant decisions of the UTM Scientific Council.
- 1.6 In order to solve its goals and problems, to implement long-term plans, the society cooperates with the scientific part of the UTM, the Student Council, chairs and other divisions.
- 1.7 The name of the company is; Armenian- Ավանդական բժշկության համալսարանի Ուսանողական Գիտական Ընկերություն, Russian- Студенческое Научное Общество Университета Традиционной Медицины, English- Student Scientific Society of the University of Traditional Medicine of Armenia. And the abbreviated names; Armenian- ԱԲՀ ՈւԳԸ, Russian- CHO UTM, English- SSS UTM. Society's address: 38 Babajanyan, Avan, Yerevan.

II. The purpose and objectives of the society

- 2.1 The purpose of the society is to contribute to the scientific, creative and spiritual development of students.

2.2 The main objectives and activities of the company are:

- supporting and implementing student's initiatives in scientific and educational fields,
- organization of student conferences, seminars, public scientific lectures and other scientific and educational oriented events, including extracurricular scientific potential,
- purposeful use of university youth scientific potential and information system about it,
- provision of comprehensive support to gifted students,
- inclusion of students in scientific groups and various scientific programs,
- publication of students' scientific works and other materials,
- establishment of contact with other scientific centers and exchange of information,
- under the supervision and guidance of the head of the scientific department, participation in the process of applying for grant programs.

III. The structure of the society and governing body

3.1 The governing body of the UTM's Student Scientific Society is the Council of the Student Scientific Society, whose session is convened no less than twice per academic semester.

3.2 The members of the SSS of the UTM include the President, the Deputy President, and the Secretary of the UTM.

3.3 The Board of SSS

- discusses and decides the most important directions of the activities of the SSS, takes measures for the implementation of decisions,
- submits recommendations to the UTM's Scientific Council,
- takes note of the annual report of the President of the SSS,
- develops current and prospective plans of the company,
- confirms its working procedure,
- creates, reorganizes and resolves the working units of the SSS not defined by this regulation, as well as approves their composition and work procedure, and may authorize them to resolve certain issues related to their jurisdiction,
- decides to grant the title of honorary member of the company and regulates other matters related to the membership of the company,
- ratifies contracts and agreements concluded on behalf of the company,

3.4 The work of the UTM's SSS is supervised by the head of the Scientific Department of the UTM. The company organizes its activities with the participation and leadership of the head of the scientific department of the university.

3.5 A session of the Board of the UTM's SSS is legal if more than 1/2 of the total number of members participate in it. Decisions are made by a simple majority of the total number. An extraordinary session of the Council can be convened at the request of the president of the SSS, 1/3 of the members of the scientific council.

IV. The members of the Board of SSS

4.1 The president of the Student Scientific Society is approved by the Scientific Council of the UTM, for three years, upon the presentation of the Rector of the UTM,

4.2 The president of the SSS is ex officio a member of the Scientific Council of the Academy of Sciences,

4.3 The president of the company officially represents the company, coordinates the activities of the company board, ensures the cooperation of the structural units of the company, issues power of attorneys, signs contracts and agreements on behalf of the company.

4.4 The president of the SSS presents an annual report to the Scientific Council of the Academy of Sciences.

4.5 The deputy president of the company takes over his powers in the absence of the president, coordinates the work of the secretariat and the activities of the working groups established by the Board of the SSS, reports on the work done.

4.6 The secretary of the company manages the work of the secretariat, guided by the working procedure of the SSS's board.

V. Society's funds, resources and the procedure for their use

5.1 The funds of the company are generated from deductions from the budget of the UTM, allocations made by sponsors and other sources not prohibited by RA legislation.

5.2 The society uses the territorial, property, technical and other resources of the ABU free of charge, according to the established procedure.

5.3 The funds of the society are used for the implementation of statutory goals and objectives.

5.4 Involvement of human resources. In order to improve communication among the students, as well as to carry out the work more efficiently, the student scientific society has the right to involve assistant-programmers (facilitator) in its work. Assistant-programmers are selected from the student population on

a voluntary basis, taking into account the scientific, professional and organizational skills of the given student. Assistant-programmers are appointed from all groups, a maximum of 2 people from each group; their candidacy is proposed by the president of SSS or the head of the scientific department, approved by the head of the scientific department. Assistant-programmer responsibilities include: under the coordination of the SSS president, participation in the scientific part and the programs implemented by the SSS, their coverage among students, implementation of organizational activities within the framework of SSS programs, promotion of students' involvement in scientific and scientific-practical programs and events, support for SSS works. The assistant-programmer is not considered a member of SSS, but in the case of successful implementation of the works, the possibility of becoming such in the future can be considered. In individual cases, according to the established procedure, the scientific work performed within the framework of the assistant-programmer's powers can be considered independent student work and taken into account in the context of the evaluation rating system.

VI. The procedure for termination of the company's activity

- 6.1 The company terminates its activity by the decision of the Scientific Council of the UTM or in accordance with the procedure established by the RA legislation.
- 6.2 After the dissolution of the company, all its property and funds belong to the University of Traditional Medicine.
