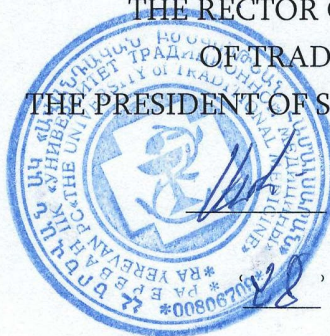

REGULATION  
ON STUDENT COUNCIL OF UNIVERSITY OF TRADITIONAL MEDICINE

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The Student Council of the University of Traditional Medicine (hereinafter - the Student Council of the University of Traditional Medicine) is a representative, self-governing body of students.
2. The SC UTM is a non-political, non-partisan and intra-campus organization.
3. The SC UTM expresses and protects the interests of students, promotes their educational, scientific, creative physical, moral and spiritual development.
4. The SC UTM carries out its activities in accordance with the Constitution of the Republic of Armenia, the current legislation of the Republic of Armenia and this Regulation.
5. The SC UTM may have a corner stamp, a letter of appointment and the right to dispose of the financial resources acquired through its activities and donations.
6. The full name of the SC of the UTM is:

II. OBJECTIVES AND MAIN DIRECTIONS OF ACTIVITY OF THE SC UTM

The SC UTM carries out its activities based on the following goals:

8. to protect the interests and rights of students,

9. to ensure the participation of students in the management of the university in matters related to students,
10. to participate in the discussions of other issues related to the university's activities in the university's governing bodies,
11. to support the development and implementation of programs aimed at the organization of the educational process and increasing the effectiveness of teaching,
12. to inform students about their rights and responsibilities,
13. to unite the students of the university, to contribute to the formation of a favorable environment for students and promote the scientific, educational, spiritual, cultural, creative and physical development of students,
14. to organize students' free entertainment and rest,
15. to participate in the maintenance of internal discipline in the territory of the UTM,
16. to cooperate with university, student, youth and other organizations operating in RA and abroad, as well as with private individuals, building relationships on the basis of contractual and cooperation and mutual benefit.
17. If possible, carry out publishing activities, sociological and other types of research, consulting.
18. The SC can form committees and organize work in the following areas:
  - ✦ cultural, the purpose of which is the moral and psychological development of students,
  - ✦ sports, whose members are responsible for organizing sports competitions and events from time to time,
  - ✦ entertainment and recreation, the main purpose of which is to provide interesting entertainment for students,
  - ✦ of progress, the members of which should try to create competition among students by declaring the best student every semester,
  - ✦ external relations and relations, whose members should contact other universities by organizing meetings.

### III. The structure of The SC UTM, management bodies and functions of these bodies

19. The SC is headed by the President of the SC, who

- conducts the meetings of the SC, organizes various discussions related to academic and student life,
- submits annual report on the activities of the SC to the rectorate,
- offers the positions of vice president and secretary,
- any student who has high performance and demonstrated organizational skills during his studies can be elected as the President of the SC.

20. At the first session of the SC, the vice-chairman and secretary of the SC are elected by a simple majority of the votes of the participants of the session.

The SC is composed of:

- a) from the president,
- b) from the vice president,
- c) from the secretary,
- d) from members of the SC.

21. The Chairman of the Council of Ministers is elected from among the members of the Council of Ministers by secret ballot for a two-year term. In case of expiration of the specified term or completion of studies at the UTM, the President of the SC resigns its powers.

22. In the absence of the President, the Vice-President performs all functions of the President, and in the presence of the President, assists him.

23. The sessions of the SC presidency are chaired by the SC president and recorded by the SC secretary.

24. One student from each course is included in the SC by self-nomination or by nomination of the students of the given course.

25. The issues to be discussed by the SC are:

- ✦ to discuss the charter of the SC,
- ✦ to elect the president of the student council and, on the recommendation of the president, to elect a vice-president and secretary,
- ✦ to discuss the annual work plan,
- ✦ to discuss the previous year's report.

26. The SC's meetings are held according to the annual work plan.

27. In the case of the president of the SC, the member of the SC graduating from the university or termination of student rights for other reasons, as well as leaving the SC at his/her own request

or in the event that the fulfillment of his powers becomes impossible due to health problems, new elections of the above-mentioned member are held.

28. The composition of the SC is replenished at the beginning of each academic year.

#### IV. The Reorganization of the SC

29. The SC UTM is reorganized by the decision of 2/3 of the members of the SC UTM.
